## 4. Drama Classes - Year 4 to 12

- PRODUCTION:** Students will develop, rehearse and perform a scripted and/or devised work which will be performed for an audience.
- IMPROVISATION:** Students will develop creative thinking and performance skills through improvisation on given themes, Theatre Sports games and associated activities with an aim to perform for an audience.
- ACTING:** (Year 7 to 12 only) Students will learn the different styles of acting – screen acting, Shakespearean, Method acting, Comedy etc.
- TRINITY:** Students eligible for Trinity Speech and Drama must have undertaken classes in 2016. Examination fees will be an additional cost.

## 5. Music and Drama - Terms and Conditions

- Lesson fees are based on 30 per year over 4 terms. Additional lessons beyond 30 will be charged to your fee account at the end of the year. If a student does not receive 30 lessons by the end of the year, a credit will be given on your fee account.
- All students taking music lessons receive a Music Diary for each instrument they learn at a cost of \$10 which will be billed to your fee account. Books and music accessories (reeds, strings etc) are ordered through the Music Department and charged to your account under 'Music Expenses'.
- If a student is absent from school through illness, term-time holiday or they forget to attend their lesson, the normal lesson charges will apply. Charges will not apply if the student is on a school excursion.
- If the teacher is absent and a replacement teacher is not available, the lesson will not be charged.
- Music lessons – Woodwind and Brass (Year 4 and above); Guitar (Year 5 and above); Singing (Year 2 and above); Strings and Piano (Prep and above).
- Students in Prep and Year 1 must be accompanied to music lessons by a Parent/Guardian.
- Notice of withdrawal – written notice, via email must be addressed to the relevant Performing Arts Administrator TWO weeks before the end of term, otherwise tuition fees for the following term will be charged.
