## **Rules and Risk Management Conditions**

- This event will be run in accordance with current EA rules.
- All dressage tests are ridden in a 60m x 20m arena.
- Primary classes are open to all students currently enrolled in a primary school (Prep to Year 6).
- Secondary classes are open to all students currently enrolled in a secondary school (Year 7 to Year 12).
- All riders must be accompanied by an adult.
- No riders other than those competing are allowed to ride at the equestrian centre.
- Riders may ride more than one horse / One Rider per horse rule applies.
- All riders must wear approved helmets and boots at all times whilst mounted.
- Full school equestrian uniform must be worn.
- Schools are responsible for gear check.
- Riders to provide own bridle / saddle numbers.
- In the combined training no whips allowed in the dressage phase, whips up to 75cm allowed in the jumping phase.
- Whips up to 120cm allowed in the pure dressage competition for horses and 100cm for ponies.
- Champion Team means top 4 scores from each school.
- A horse and rider combination may participate in a maximum of two dressage tests and one show jumping round.
- Dressage only riders may ride a max of two tests.
- Spurs permitted.
- No refunds after closing date, unless a valid veterinary or medical certificate supplied within 7 days of notification. All refunds will incur a \$15 administration fee.
- Primary CT 35cm and Primary Dress Prep C is for children that are in primary school and are inexperienced, please do not enter this class if the rider is graded higher than PCAV 5, has competed in show jumping competitions with a start height of 45cm, is confident cantering.
- Secondary Freshman combined training is to encourage riders with no/very little competition experience or riders that may have competed in dressage but never competed in jumping.
